VISA / Residence Permit	<p>If you are a citizen from a country belonging to the European Union, you will not need to follow any administrative procedure to become a UPC full time student.</p> <p>Students from countries not belonging to the European Union who come to study for more than three months must apply for a student visa at the Spanish embassy in their home country. ECTS Grade	% of successful students normally achieving the grade	Definition
A	10	EXCELLENT: outstanding performance with only minor errors.
B	25	VERY GOOD: above the average standard but some errors.
C	30	GOOD: generally sound work with a number of notable errors.
D	25	SATISFACTORY: fair but with significant shortcomings.
E	10	SUFFICIENT: performance meets the minimum criteria.
FX	--	MARGINAL FAIL: some work required before the credit can be awarded.
F	--	FAIL: Considerable further work is required.
