




## **Application Procedures**

- Step 1: Complete application online: www.pittstate.edu/apply
  - Application Fee Waiver
- Step 2: Submit supporting documents
  - UPC nomination letter
  - transcripts (English translation)
  - proof of financial support (bank statement)
  - TOEFL, IELTS, PTE, or Duolingo score
  - copy of passport
  - tuition deposit

Email all documents to: i-admit@pittstate.edu

- Application deadlines:
  - Fall (August) Semester: June 1
  - Spring (January) Semester: October 15



### **GPA Admission Requirement**

Undergraduate: 2.5 on a 4.0 scale

PSU will evaluate your transcript to determine your GPA.

### English Language Requirement

- TOEFL: 68 overall with 15 in each section
- IELTS: 6.0 overall with 5.0 in each section
- PTE: 47 overall
- Duolingo: 100 overall with 100 section scores



### **English Support**

For those who do not meet the English Proficiency requirement or for those who want to improve their English skills, PSU will offer these two classes at no additional cost. They are included in the flat-rate tuition.



- Form I20 (for the F1 visa)
- Admission Letter
- Scholarship Letter

#### Next you will need to:

- Complete the DS-160 Visa Application
- Schedule your visa appointment at US Embassy
- Pay the SEVIS I-901 Fee




## PSU faculty member named to list of world's top scientists

## Optional Practical Training (OPT)

After completing the PSU Degree, students are eligible to apply for work authorization called Optional Practical Training (OPT). This allows students to work for 12 months in the US in a related field while on the F1 student visa.

- 12 months OPT
- 24 months STEM OPT extension

PSU has a **Career Services Office** that will prepare students for internships. Career Fairs are held on campus to give students an opportunity to network with those professionals in the field. Jobs are not guaranteed.
