Known as "Irkutsk Polytech", Irkutsk National Research Technical University is a center of science, culture, and education in the Irkutsk Region. ELIGIBILITY

- Currently enrolled university students who have completed at least 2 semesters at home university.
- Language proficiency requirements: B1/B2 (CEFR)

APPLICATION

Exchange students from our partner universities who wish to study at INRTU for one or two semesters need to be nominated by the International Office of their home university for exchange studies at INRTU. After receipt of the nomination, the students will be asked to send the following

Application documents:

1. Application form - signed/sealed by the student and coordinator at the home university
2. Learning Agreement - program of study
3. Transcript of Records - proof of academic achievements, copy of Bachelor's degree certificate Master's level students only)
4. Proof of Russian / English language skills
5. Curriculum vitae & pasport photograph
6. Passport copy (*valid at least 6 months from the date of visa issue*)
